



## **FACULTY OF USULUDDIN**

### **INTRODUCTION**

The Faculty of Usuluddin was established in August 2007, right after the Seri Begawan Religious Teachers University College launched its first academic program. This faculty plays a crucial role in providing various disciplines of knowledge related to Usuluddin. It is led by a Dean, supported by a Deputy Dean, and comprises eight academic staff members, including Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Lecturers, and Assistant Lecturers from both local and international backgrounds. Additionally, the faculty has two non-academic staff: an Assistant Registrar and a part-time worker to facilitate the administration of the faculty.

### **VISION**

To produce and cultivate a source of teachers and educators who are pious, knowledgeable, morally upright, skilled in shaping society and the nation, promoting what is good and forbidding what is wrong, practicing the Sunnah of the Prophet Muhammad (Sallallahu 'Alaihi Wassalam), and spreading Islamic teachings.

### **MISSION**

To uphold knowledge in the field of Usuluddin and Religious Education through teaching, learning, training, research, and community service, based on the Qur'an and Sunnah, with the concept of Malay Islamic Monarchy and the Philosophy of National Education.

2. To train, equip, and develop human resources who are pious, competent, proactive, and responsible.

4. To provide consultation in Islamic teachings to public service personnel and the wider community.



## **PROGRAMS OFFERED**

The Faculty of Usuluddin is responsible for preparing, offering, and assessing programs related to Usuluddin. The medium of instruction is Malay, except for the Doctor of Philosophy and Master's programs, which use Arabic Language. The four programs offered are:

1. Doctor of Philosophy in Religious Education (Usuluddin)
2. Master's in Religious Education (Usuluddin)
3. Diploma in Tauhid (Monotheism) Studies
4. Diploma in Tafsir and Hadith Studies
